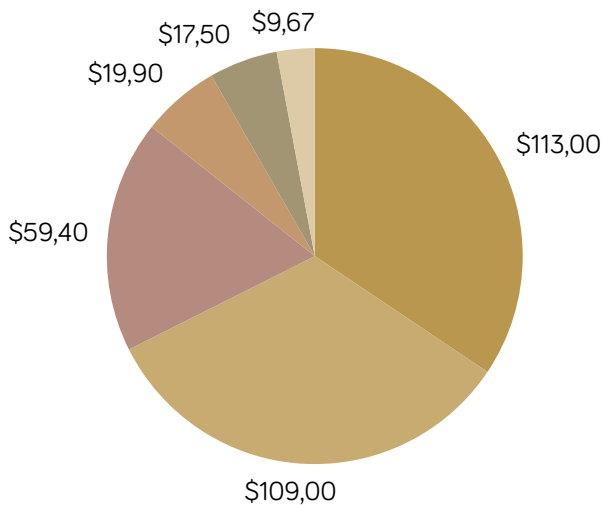

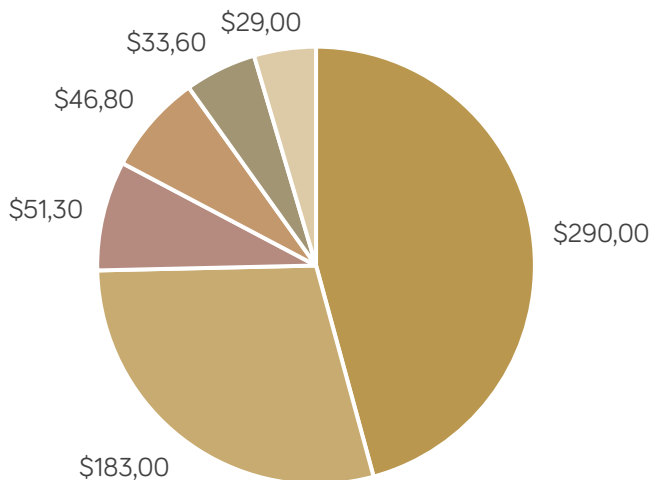
**2021 top 6 fine food exports in USD Million: \$328,47\***

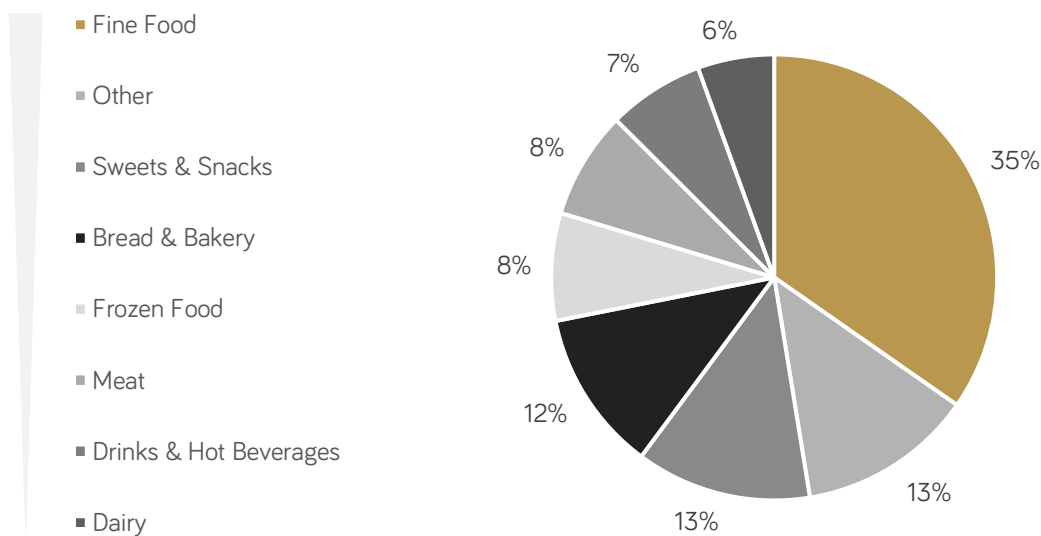

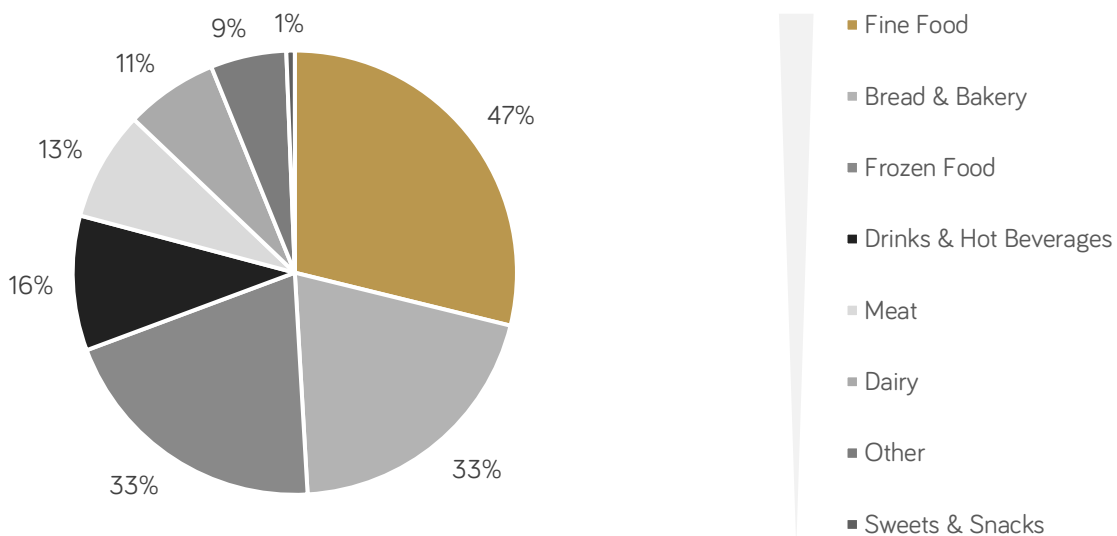
